

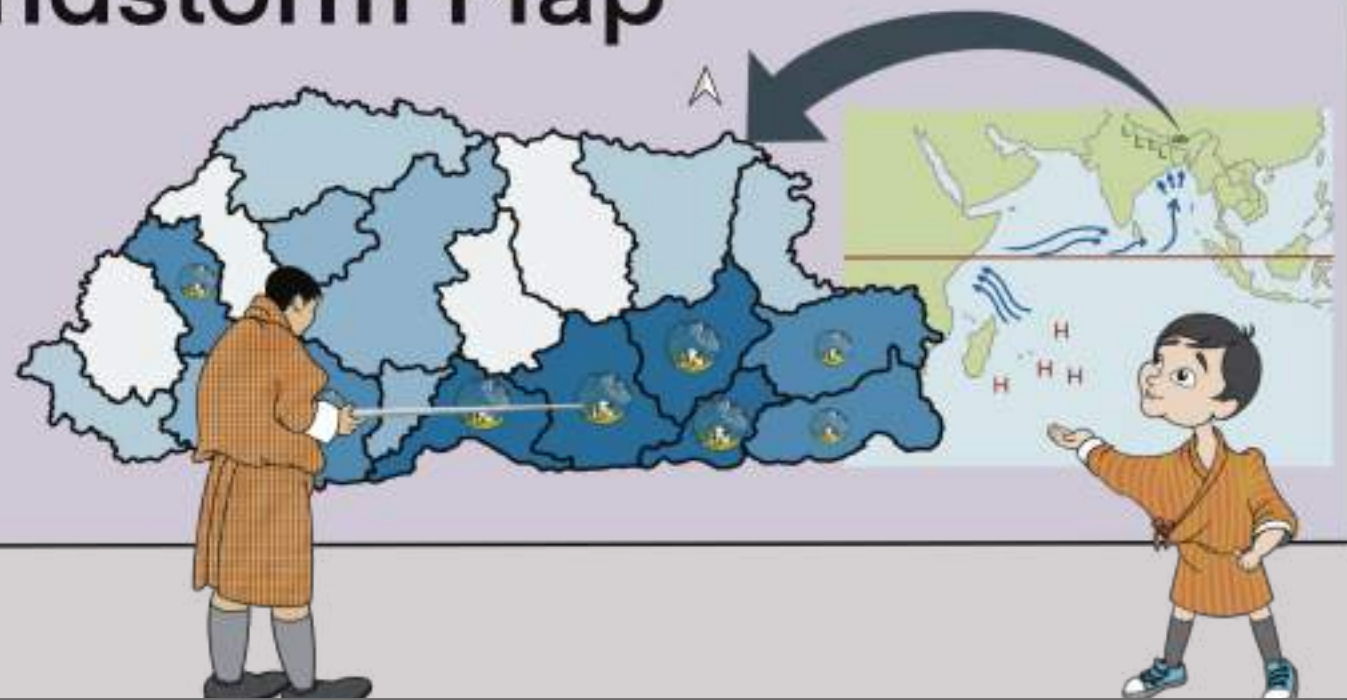
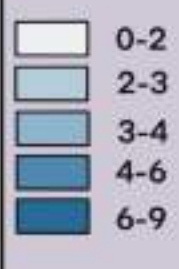


WINDSTORM SAFETY

Know the history and risks of windstorm in your area

Design and build windstorm resistant roofs



Periodically check the stability of roofing, windows and doors



Identify safe places in and outside your building



Monitor weather and get information from relevant agencies



During and after a windstorm

IF YOU ARE INDOOR

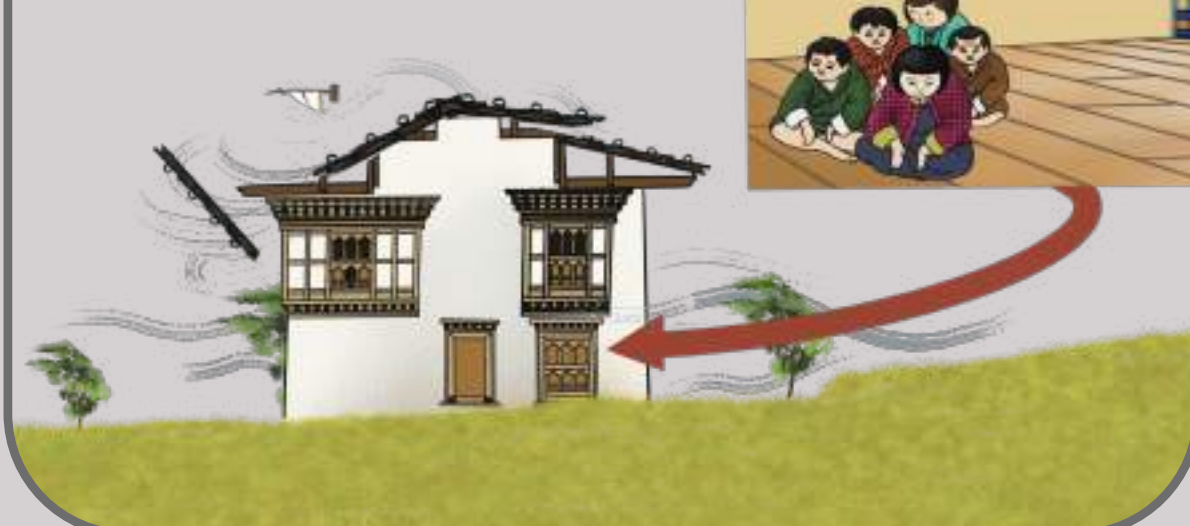


Close all windows and doors



Stay indoor away from all windows and doors. Turn off electricity and other appliances

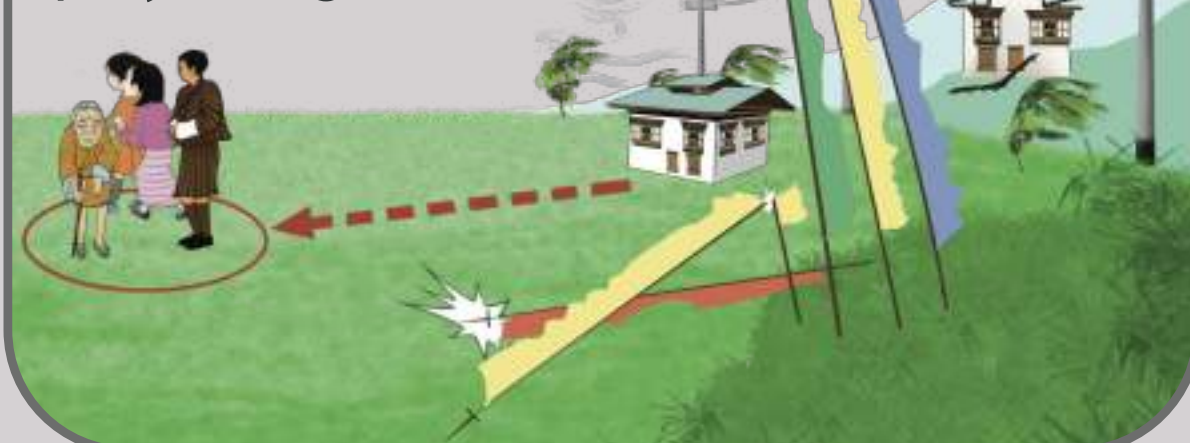
Evacuate to lower floors of an identified safe location in the house



If you live in a temporary and unstable structure, evacuate to a stronger shelter

IF YOU ARE OUTDOOR

Take shelter in a nearby safe structure. If there is no safe shelter go to open place away from electric poles, prayer flags, etc.



If you are driving pull over to a safe place and stay inside



Check and assess building conditions before entering your house
